How to Evaluate a Source!

Fact
Finders

1 Check a Fact Finder!

- Double check the info on a fact-checker (like snopes.com or politifact.com.)
- Type the claim or article title into google + the word "fact check"

A

Authority

2 Research the Authority!

- Look up publisher, author & website title.
- Are they reliable & trustworthy?
- Run their names through mediabiasfactcheck, google, or wikipedia to see what other sources say about them.

C

Corroborate

3 Corroborate / Cross Check

- Reliable info will be corroborated & supported by other reliable sources.
- Check to see if other, unrelated sources confirm the same info your source claims.

T

Try Again

4 Try again if needed!

- If source checks out, no 2nd try needed.
- If not, look for a new source!
